

Using the Personal Learning Plan (PLP) in Infinite Campus

Who?

- Students coming through the Problem-Solving Teams (typically new students or students not yet identified with an ILP, IEP, etc)
- Students receiving targeted or intensive intervention who are not identified with other documentation

When?

- Student's are placed on a PLP when they are not responding to Tier 1 intervention and Tier 2 intervention is deemed necessary
- The consultant on the PST/SIT team will help the referring teacher begin this documentation process

Why?

- The PLP will help us consistently document the Rtl process throughout the district
- If there is an ILP or IEP in place, a PLP is NOT required-- it is up to the team to decide if a PLP is needed

- Even if the student has an ILP or another type of plan, it may serve us well to document the services so this data can be used in staffing allotment decisions
